Risk Assessment Addendum School Parking Marton

This Addendum provides further photographic evidence (recorded 1st Feb. 2016) of the serious risk that parents and children can encounter on School Lane at school drop off and pick up times. With no footpath, parents and children have to take refuge between parked cars before continuing their perilous journey down the centre of the lane, with traffic passing in very close proximity, as the photographs clearly show.

The photographs also show cars parked on the stretch of road where the access to the proposed development site will be located. Any additional traffic emerging from the proposed housing estate on to School Lane at school time will make an already dangerous situation even worse. To suggest that this proposal is in any way sustainable should not be given credence. The attached letter from a parent whose children attend Marton School sums up the views of the residents and parents: **“it does not make any kind of logical sense”**.

Comments My daughters both attend Marton CofE school. The provision for parking near the school is already limited, and parents have little option but to walk their children along the road in the path of traffic. This is already a dangerous situation; to consider adding to this by increasing the number of residences along this narrow stretch of road does not make any kind of logical sense; and, in fact, is verging on ludicrous. I do not believe that School Lane has the capacity to accommodate the proposed plan, and never will, without widening the road and providing a safe pavement for pedestrians. This solution would, of course, have a severe detrimental impact on existing residents, and cannot be considered acceptable.
